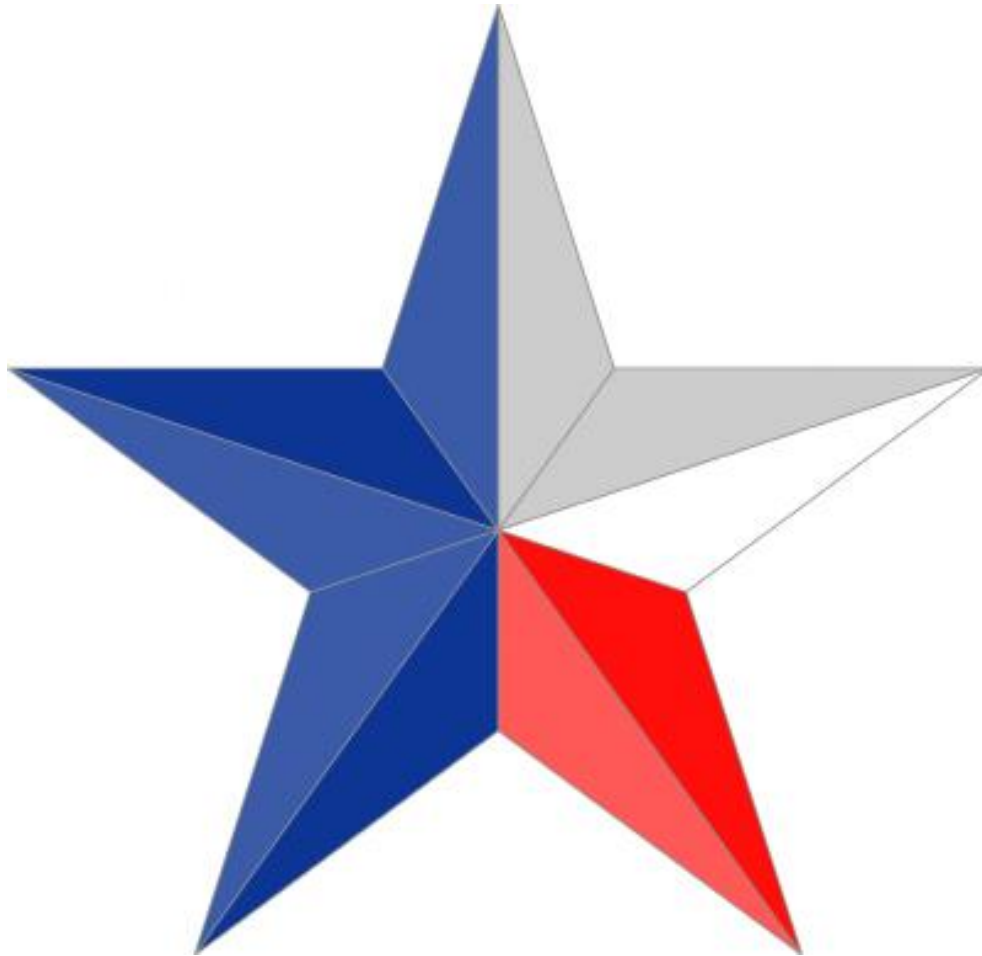

Chuck Knesel was the voice of Texas Diving for decades. There wasn't a diving meet at Texas Swimming Center (TSC) in the 80's and 90's where his voice wasn't booming over the PA, announcing divers and reading their scores. Like most parents of divers, he and his wife Sherel became involved in helping with meets when their daughter Julie dove with Longhorn Aquatics. After many all-nighters spent organizing dive sheets, orders, lists and other meet paperwork, Chuck drew on his experience working at IBM to write a dive meet program that checked dive sheets and printed the first dive sheets to be used at the table. In an age when computers were not reliable, his software helped streamline and modernize meet operations. His meet system was a hit and with Sherel, they traveled the state and country running numerous Junior, Senior, local, Zone and National meets, including all UT, UIL, district and state dive meets in Austin. When Julie became a University of Texas Diver, Chuck and Sherel were asked to run Olympic Festival, USA Diving and FINA meets, culminating in 1996 when their expertise and experience were recognized by their running the diving score table at the Atlanta Olympics.

Chuck was a loved and cherished member of the Texas and USA Diving community. Divers always dropped by the score table to say hi, catch up and get a hug. He brought much joy to divers, coaches and those lucky enough to work with him. In his honor, memory and spirit we host this meet. We hope you will join us for the Chuck Knesel Memorial Invitational, in honor of a friend who gave so much to the sport of diving and Longhorn Aquatics.

2014 Chuck Knesel Memorial Invitational March 22-23

Longhorn Aquatics diving team invites you to join us in Austin TX at the Lee and Joe Jamail Texas Swimming Center (TSC) to compete in the 2014 Chuck Knesel Memorial Invitational. This meet is open to all level divers (JO, Novice and Future Champion) and will include individual and synchronized events.

Facility: The diving well at the TSC is an indoor, 15-18' deep, 25'x25' pool with four 1M & six 3M Duraflex boards and full platform set (1M, 3M, 5M, 7M and 10M). The pool is located on the University of Texas campus, one block west of I-35 on the northwest corner of the intersection of Martin Luther King Boulevard and Red River Street.

Address: 1900 Red River Street, Austin, Texas 78712

Sanction: This meet has been sanctioned by AAU (4KSTDI1038); all teams, coaches & divers must be AAU members to register for the meet.

Registration: Divers may register online at DiveMeets.com until Friday, March 21th at 9am Central Time. Participants that become AAU members after the online deadline, may deck enter the meet only if they can present their 2013-2014 AAU card.

Online Entries: \$35 per individual and synchro event (\$17.5 per diver per synchro event); some synchro events are mixed, boys & girls may pair up.

Registration and On-Deck Entries:

- Friday, March 21; 5-8pm
 - Saturday, March 22; 7am until the end of competition
 - Sunday, March 23; 7am until 1.5 hours prior to last event starts
 - Deadline to register for each event is 1.5 hour before the event starts
- Deck entries for divers not registered at all for the meet on DiveMeets.com will be accepted. Individual events will have a \$20 late fee per event. No late fee for synchro events. Must present 2013-2014 AAU card.
 - Deck entries are \$35 per individual and synchro event (\$17.5 per diver per synchro event).
 - We will accept credit cards (Visa or MasterCard), cash, and checks (made payable to University of Texas).
 - Divers may switch events if signed up for the wrong event on deck without penalty.
 - Divers may participate in events outside their age group (compete up in age).

Awards: Medals awarded to top 3 places and ribbons awarded to 4th - 8th places. Awards ceremony will take place immediately following each event.

TSC Rules: As guests of The University of Texas, all must adhere to the TSC rules. Coaches must supervise their athletes. Chewing gum and glass containers are not permitted in the building. Wet divers cannot leave pool deck. Children must be supervised at all times. Spectators and athletes may not bring food or drink into the Texas Swim Center from outside sources. Teams ARE permitted to bring one cooler on to the deck.

Deck Access: Only currently registered divers, coaches, officials and meet volunteer will be allowed access beyond the front desk of the TSC. Any non-registered individuals not respecting these rules will be removed from that area or from the facility at the discretion of the meet director, Longhorn Aquatics Program Director or TSC staff.

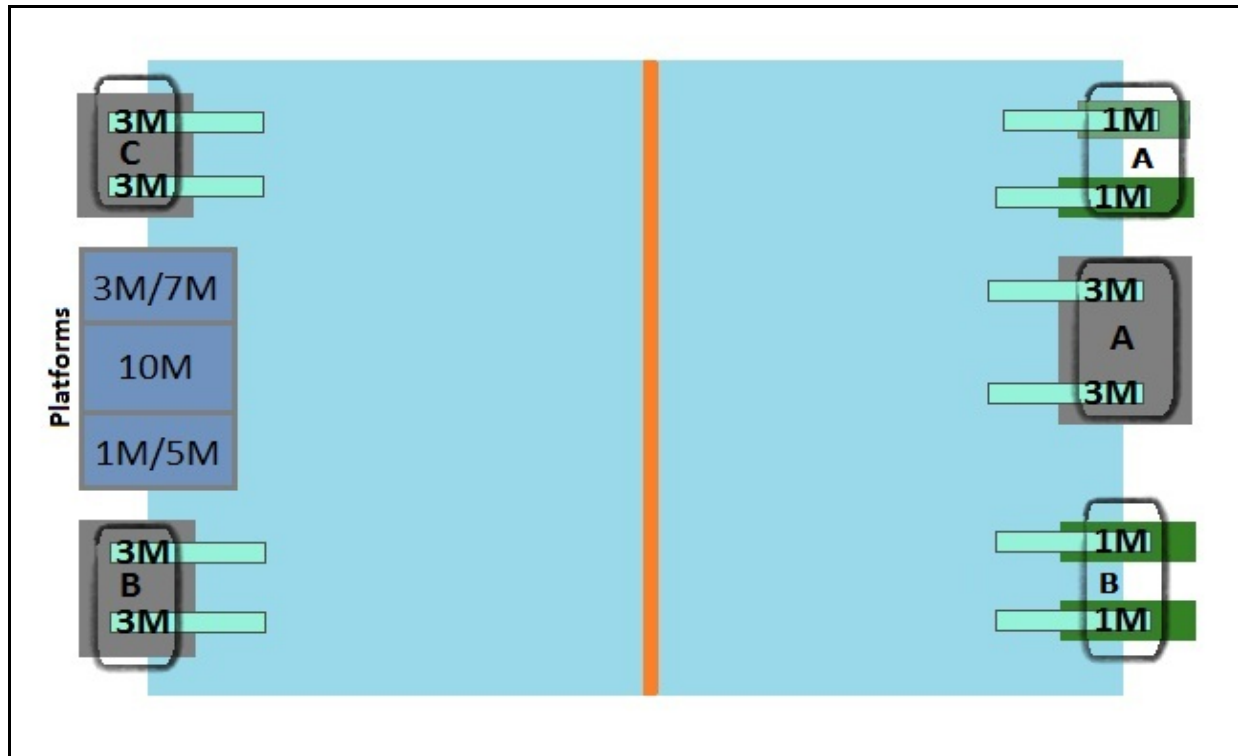

Dive 2: 200 (A or C) no arm-swing back jump straight or tuck; DD 1.0

Dive 3: 100 (A or C) no arm-swing one (1) step hurdle front jump straight or tuck; DD 1.0

Dive 4: 100 (A or C) approach¹ front jump straight or tuck; DD 1.0

Dive 5: 001D or 002D front or back lineup (may be standing or seating); DD 1.0

FC White

Dive 1: 200 (B or C) back jump pike or tuck; DD 1.0

Dive 2: 100 (B or C) approach¹ front jump pike or tuck; DD 1.0

Dive 3: 001D front lineup (may be standing or seating); DD 1.0

Dive 4: 100 (A, B or C) approach¹ front jump straight, pike or tuck; DD 1.0

Dive 5: 002D, 101, 102, 201, 202, 401 (A, B or C); true DD

1. Approach: any hurdle 3 step minimum, any triple bounce, any running approach on platform
2. Divers may receive assistance on 610A & 611D (holding diver's feet for a max score of 4 from each judge)
3. Divers may compete multiple synchro teams with different partners, mixed gender and no age group

Open Rules

Bronze events are compatible to USA Junior 11 & Under.

Silver individual events are compatible to USA Junior 12-13 and 14-15.

Silver synchro is compatible to USA Junior and Senior female synchro format.

Gold events are a mixture of USA Junior 16-18 and USA Senior format.

Gold synchro is compatible to USA Junior and Senior male synchro format.
